MedWeb Extends the Power of Existing PACS Installations with a New Automated Patient Screening Suite

Cloud computing module integrates with any existing PACS to help radiologists increase revenue by offering additional screening tools and reports.

SAN FRANCISCO, CA and CHICAGO, IL, November 29, 2009 – Medweb announced today a new Health Screening Suite application that extends the power of PACS to common screening tests that can help clinicians assess a patients overall health. Comprised of six modules – Calcium Scoring, Bone Density Scoring, Virtual Colonoscopy, Abdominal Fat Density Scoring, Stress Tests and Echocardiograms – the application can be added to a facility’s existing PACS or integrated with Medweb’s PACS. The announcement was made in conjunction with the annual meeting of the Radiological Society of North America (RSNA), held November 29 through December 3 in Chicago.

The new Web-based Health Screening Suite application is designed to provide automated patient assessment reports that are then integrated with the regular radiologist report. This mechanism provides substantial value add without increasing the workload for the radiologist. It can also be used to enhance reading services and increase referrals from specialists, such as cardiologists, gastroenterologists, and obstetrician/gynecologists who now are looking for more detailed health screening tools from the medical imaging community.

Each screening test in the module computes a score based on objective information obtained from the diagnostic imaging study, typically a CT scan or an echocardiogram for the stress test. Medweb’s PACS already provides viewing capabilities for echocardiograms as part of its standard features.

“Radiologists are looking for ways to increase the value of their reading services and, through teleradiology, attract referrals from any health services facility regardless of

location,” says Peter Killcommons, MD, CEO, Medweb. “Medweb’s new Health Screening Suite module extends teleradiology’s reach with an easy-to-use solution that can be bolted onto any facility’s existing PACS.”

The comprehensive health assessment provides patients and their referring physicians with the most advanced, non-invasive screening technologies that can help detect disease at an earlier stage. By integrating this software-based module with any existing RIS/PACS platform, radiologists can provide client health assessments without incurring additional capital expense.
